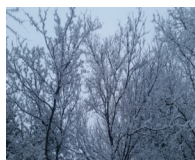

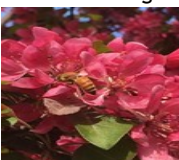

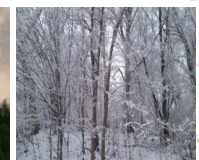

### Its time for the St. John’s Preschool Annual Bowl-a-Thon!

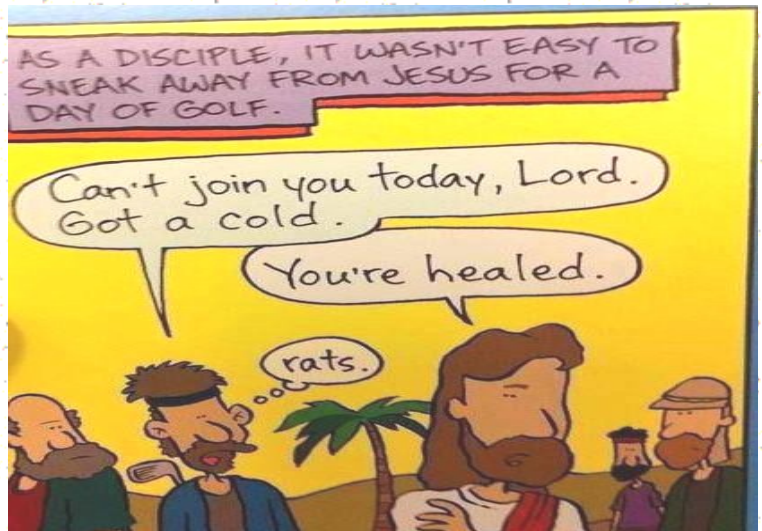

**Mission Fair Wrap Up:**

- Needs to be better advertised.

- Set up around perimeter of dining hall for better visibility.
