A DISCIPLINED DISCIPLE

It's no coincidence that the words disciple and discipline are linked together. A quick word search from the NRSV translation of the bible, which is what we use on a regular basis at St. John's, shows that the words disciple or disciples appears in the books of Matthew-Acts a total of 270 times in 255 verses. Other translations for the term disciple include **learner**, **pupil**, and **apprentice**. After searching for the word discipline or disciplined, the NRSV reveals 71 occurrences in 70 verses (the most appear in Proverbs a total of 13 times). Other translations for discipline include **instruct or train**. Summarizing these two terms, it reveals to us that a disciplined disciple is one who is very committed to training.

There are many instances when Jesus teaches about discipleship, none more noteworthy than when he says, "Whoever does not carry the cross and follow me cannot be my disciple." (Luke 14:27) That's serious business! When I read such a powerfully charged statement, it brings to mind the importance of sacrifice for others, doing the difficult and right thing in God's eyes. Jesus bore that cross as he practiced what he preached. His followers therefore learned one final lesson on sacrifice.

As we enter the month of November when many of us commit ourselves to year end giving, I want to lift up some opportunities where your dollars can make a tremendous differ-
